
Step 4: Enter your login credentials for your student account, which will take you to any of the following dashboards. Select the enroll button from your navigation menu.



You will then be prompted to a page that looks like this:



Step 5: Choose the program that fits your needs. Then, click on your subject and find the course you are enrolling in. You will also be asked to choose your competencies. If you plan on taking a half-credit course, choose each competency from the segment. If you plan to take a full-credit course, choose the competencies from segments one and two, and add them to your backpack.



Step 6: Go to your backpack and submit your request. Students have the option to learn through courses, projects, or experiences. You can find out more about these learning options by visiting our website. If you plan on learning through projects, select the projects learning path. If you plan on learning through experiences, please enroll in an experiences course, such as, "English 1 Experiences."
