



- <u>Grades 9-12</u>: True Crime, Mythology, Photography, Travel with Your Tastebuds, Art in 2D, Outside the Box Creative Writing

New Courses Available Now

• <u>Middle School Math 2 Accelerated</u>: Combines Grade 7 and 8 math, preparing students for Algebra 1.

• <u>Middle School Exploring Interests & Careers</u>: Helps students discover their talents and potential career paths through self-assessment activities.

• <u>Early College Online</u>: Offers dual credit courses taught by CCSNH faculty, where students earn college credit through CCSNH and high school credit through VLACS. The fall semester begins on August 26.
